## PLAINTIFF'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR REDISTRIBUTION OF RESIDUAL FUNDS FROM CLASS ACTION SETTLEMENT

Plaintiff Andre Brown ("Plaintiff"), by and through his undersigned counsel, hereby respectfully moves the Court for approval for the Settlement Administrator to redistribute the residual funds from the parties' class action settlement to class members who cashed or deposited their settlement check, before donating such funds to *cy pres*. In support, Plaintiff states as follows:

- 1. On March 16, 2021, this Court granted final approval to the parties' class action settlement agreement, which established a non-reversionary Settlement Fund of \$762,300.00 to be distributed *pro rata* to the 693 class members after payment of settlement administration costs, attorneys' fees, and an incentive award to Plaintiff as class representative. (*See* Exhibit 2.)
- 2. The Settlement Administrator mailed checks to each of the 693 class members for \$666.91 each (or \$506.85 for those who required backup tax withholding). Those checks became void 90 days after issuance, on September 14, 2021.

The capitalized terms used in this motion are those used in the Stipulation of Class Action Settlement (the "Settlement" or "Agreement"), attached hereto as Exhibit 1.

3. Before the void date for the initial wave of checks, 18 class members requested that their checks be reissued. The Settlement Administrator reissued a check to all of those class

members.

4. The void date has now passed for all reissued checks, and there is \$110,512.97 in

residual funds remaining in the Settlement Fund due to individuals not cashing the checks.

5. The Court's final approval order directed that any residual funds be donated as *cy* 

pres to the Illinois Bar Foundation, the Cook County Bar Association, and Chicago Legal Aid, in

equal amounts. (Exhibit  $2 ext{ } ext{ } ext{ } ext{17.}$ )

6. However, given the substantial amount of residual funds, Plaintiff believes that it

is in the best interest of the Settlement Class to redistribute the funds to class members who

cashed their checks the first time around before resorting to cy pres.

7. The Settlement Administrator estimates that it would cost approximately

\$12,519.50 to complete a redistribution to the 475 class members who cashed or deposited their

first check. If the Court approves redistribution, after deducting the estimated administration

costs, each of those 475 class members would receive a check for an additional \$206.30.

8. To the extent that any redistributed checks are not cashed or deposited within 90

days of issuance, those funds will be donated to the previously approved cy pres recipients.

9. Prior to filing this motion, Plaintiff's counsel conferred with counsel for

Defendant Moran Foods, LLC, and Defendant has no objection to the request.
